

## Monitoring by the Medias and *Le Devoir* Newspaper

I am a civilian from the general public. I write to you about a problem that I have with some of your chroniclers.

Since 2005-2006, after having contacted the medias (your newspaper amongst others), I am being monitored.

Everytime there are controversies or huge public affairs stories, the medias make reference to me and violate my privacy.

In your newspaper, the chronicler Josée Blanchette is always after me. She spices her chronicles by making reference to my privacy and my conversations, which are all registered since I have communicated with the medias. It is useless to explain to you how it can be done. You certainly know that in today's world it's possible to put someone under surveillance like this.

When she targets me, Madam Blanchette is often making reference to me by referring to Vermont and using a rhetoric which aims at targeting and manipulating people who have conservative or traditional values. One of the last stories I was targeted by is the controversy surrounding a publicity for Greiche & Scaff. They have done this because I have to change my glasses. This publicity and this controversy got out after a period of time where I had conversations about my glasses. Everytime there is something going on in my life, it is followed by media feedback and it's been like this since 2006. Here, it is Winston McQuade who is at the center of this controversy, but his girl Pénélope McQuade also has been targeting me like this for many years. This is all being done in association with the companies and publicity agencies, but your newspaper also participates through the content of the articles and chronicles.

Very often, there is a sexual aspect to this targeting, like Josée Blanchette has done in her September 2, 2016 chronicle, in complicity with Winston McQuade. Everytime there is a women in my surroundings, especially if she is good looking, there is a reaction in the medias even if I absolutely have no interest for her. Anyhow, it is not of your business.

Louis Cornellier also is often targeting me, but he's doing it more in the realm of ideas, and it is done in complicity with those who are writing the books.

This type of harassment is done using a network of people and these tactics are known and described by Nicolas Desurmont in his text entitled *Vers une problématique du harcèlement criminel en réseau*.

I ask you to please stop all these monitoring activities at my expense. It is very unpleasant and it constitutes a violation of my privacy.
